

DOOR DECORATING RULES

1. The following guidelines must be observed by all participants.
2. Only the Exterior of the Door (outside face) is to be decorated.
3. Teachers are only allowed to have 1 door decorated. If a classroom happens to have more than 1 door, pick one.
4. Decorations may not cover the windows of the door or block movement into or out of the classroom. Door handles must remain visible and operational.
 - a. If you are a Coach who is decorating the weight room door or a Door in the Gym, you may cover windows (as those doors are largely windows).
 - b. If you are a Housed Staff without a door, please contact Mr. Sinski and he will Assign you a door.
5. Decorations should not impede opening or closing the doors or prevent doors from locking at end of day.
6. Do not use materials that will damage doors. No nails, tacks, or staples may be used. All adhesives used must be removable.
7. Decorations and designs are not to exceed the Door. No decorating the walls around the door. No having things hanging into open space. The Rectangle that is the door frame is the HARD EDGE.
8. Electrical lights are not allowed (battery operated lights can be used).
9. Decorations should be appropriate to the themes and be in accordance with our school's value and mission.
10. The competition is intended to promote School & House Spirit. Therefore, all Doors should be Spartan or House Themed.
11. Doors are only allowed to be decorated by members of that House. A student does not have to be TAUGHT by that teacher to decorate that door. (ie. Mr. Butler is the Head of Zeus. ANY ZEUS students can decorate that door regardless of if Mr. Butler is their teacher or not, BUT ONLY ZEUS STUDENTS.)
12. The design for the door must be approved by the teacher.
13. **TEACHERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO ACTIVELY HELP IN ANY WAY. (Teachers may not help decorate, make/design decorations, or allow students to use school-purchased supplies.** If a teacher wants to independently purchase supplies to help with their door they may. The students may also purchase supplies for the door decorations.)
14. Decorating CANNOT disrupt instruction.
15. Students CANNOT Miss Class or use class time to work on it.
 - a. A student asks if they can decorate your door because they have a 100% in your class- You Say NO!
 - b. A student asks Teacher A if they can go to Teacher B's classroom to work on their door. Teacher A should say no. If a student shows up to decorate your door, Teacher B should send the student back to class.
 - c. If a student is an aid for a teacher of their house, they cannot work on the door decorations during their aid period.
 - d. **If these rules are violated the teacher's door is disqualified and the Teachers' House will have 50 deducted from their total**
16. Doors can be decorated Before School, After School, at Lunch, or IF the Teacher/Student(s) both have a Free Period at the SAME TIME.
17. Doors may be decorated between April 20th to April 28th. Decorations may not go up before April 20th and nothing may be added to the doors after April 28th.
18. Judging will take place on April 29th by a panel of unhoused faculty.
19. Students who decorate the door are responsible for cleaning up their mess.
